ABOUT SAR/ RCMI PolyU Conference

RCMI and SAR will be jointly organizing an upcoming conference with the Research Centre for Chinese Medicine Innovation (RCMI) of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University on 23-25 MAY, 2024.

RCMI was established in October 2021 as a university-level platform to facilitate impactful interdisciplinary research at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. At present, RCMI has three main research directions: namely Management of Metabolic Syndrome and Liver Disease, Women's Health, and Integrative Solutions for Physical Wellness. RCMI is committed to foster inter-disciplinary and translational research for developing novel drugs, new treatment protocol and program based on TCM practices for application in the clinical setting or community. We will also provide consultancy services to different stakeholders in TCM quality control, TCM-based drug discovery and development, as well as treatment protocol for enhancing physical wellness for the benefit of the community. Collectively, our center provides support and leadership in bringing Chinese medicine innovations into clinical practice and relevant policy to promote safer use and good practice of Chinese medicine.

SAR, is an non-for-profit organization based in the United States of America. Co-founded by Patricia Culliton, Hannah Bradford, and Stephen Birch in 1993, began several years earlier as an informal group (the Committee for Acupuncture Research) to discuss methodological concerns in acupuncture research. SAR is currently guided by Co-Presidents Rick Harris, PhD, and Jun Mao, MD, with a total of 14 board members.

The SAR / RCMI PolyU 2024 conference, **"Bridging the Two Worlds: Engaging Traditional Chinese Medicine in Modern Health Care"** will present a platform wherein researchers from various healthcare professionals and disciplines can share, explore, and develop novel research hypotheses and strategies for acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). The primary objective of this conference is to construct a robust bridge between the East and West, with the aim of advancing the scientific understanding and evidence-based clinical applications of acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). Our goal is to enhance patient outcomes and optimize health care delivery through this integration. We seek to build bridges between basic mechanisms and precision clinical medicine, as well as ancient wisdom (e.g. personalized therapies) and modern technology (e.g. Artificial Intelligence). This fusion will not only honor the rich heritage of TCM but also pave the way for its evolution in the modern health care landscape.

This conference will include not only acupuncture research, but will also include Chinese Herbal Medicine, Qigong, and related mind-body research. During the conference, we will present the current studies, discuss both limitations and opportunities, to improve the rigor of these investigations to strengthen the evidence base.
